PROCÈS-VERBAL de l'assemblée plénière de l'Association Canadienne d'Études patristiques (CSPS), tenue à l'Université du Québec à Montréal le 31 mai 1980, à la fin de notre session avec les Sociétés Savantes.

The Secretary gives a report of our activities since the last Saskatoon meeting.

The Treasurer then distributes his financial report.

In this second French city, after Paris, we were expecting an important French participation. Or elle est numériquement minime. A ce point que l'assemblée décide de remettre au Comité exécutif le soin d'entrer de nouveau en contact avec nos amis francophones, de les intéresser aux objectifs de notre Association et à la révision du texte français de nos Constitutions. Nous espérons adopter la rédaction définitive du texte français lors de notre prochain congrès à Halifax.

The assembly decides that the Bulletin should announce where papers read by our members at Congresses are to be published.

The President informs the assembly that M. Aurèle OUMÉL, co-director (with Mr Norman DAHL) of the Information Service, Social Sciences and Humanities, Research Council of Canada (SSHRC/CRSHC): 255, Albert St., C.P. 1610, Ottawa, Ont., K1P 6G4 (613-995-9330), is the man to contact, for instance, to obtain grants for research, subsidies for the preparation of a doctoral thesis, for a particular project during a sabbatical year or during ordinary time. We must not hesitate to submit any individual or group research project.

Suit un échange sur le projet du Comité Exécutif d'augmenter le montant de la cotisation. Le Trésorier ne se montre pas favorable. Il serait en faveur de reconsidérer cette augmentation, seulement après que l'Association aura été reçue dans la Fédération Canadienne des Humanités (CFH). Le vote est pris, et l'assemblée décide maintenir le statu quo.

Concerning the social reception that our Society gives on the occasion of our Congresses, the President proposes that a first part of expenses be paid by the Society, and that the balance of expenses be borne by the attending members. Adopted.

Also proposed that: the Halifax Congress (learned 1981) be held on MAY 25 and 26 (mercredi et jeudi). Adopted. More precisely: half a day, plus a full day. Adopted.

Unanimously, Ron KYDD is elected member-at-large (for a second term).

Re: Nominating Committee. Walter PRINCIPE is re-elected, and Rodrigue BELANGER, from the Université du Québec à Rimouski, is elected to this Committee.

A few last informations are given by the President, and the General Assembly comes to a close.
