News related to CCSR (Corporation canadienne des sciences religieuses)

- "Religious Studies in Canada", a vast enquiry on the state of the discipline in the country will be published as books when completed.
- The discussion on inclusive language goes on and should soon give birth to a policy statement which will affect all CCSR member societies including CSPS/ACEP.
- Publications: Our Society is now officially included among those responsible for the publication of SR (1,262 subscribers). Publications through CCSR series are increasing: see the list of recent titles. It is enticing for CSPS/ACEP members now to submit a manuscript to one of those series: "SR Supplements", "Editions SR", "Studies in Christianity and Judaism", "The Study of Religion in Canada", "Comparative Ethics Series". Procedure: Send manuscript to the CSPS "responsible for publications" (to be appointed at the Montreal meeting); after approval by the Executive Committee the rest will follow swiftly.
