Meeting held at the University of Windsor on June 3, 1988 at 15:30.

1-2. Agenda and Minutes of June 1, 1988 were approved.

3. President's Report [Joanne McWilliam]

From CFH we hear that a commission is reviewing how SSHRC money is being used. Also that leave fellowships are definitively eliminated.

It is time to prepare a new edition of our Directory. The President is willing to take care of the new edition; it will be put on a diskette [this time including telephone numbers] and could be reviewed every year. A request for updating information will be placed in the November Bulletin and the new edition should be ready by April 1989.

The Oxford Congress was a success as usual; but overcrowded. The Canadian participation has grown [over 40 heads] and almost everyone gave a paper.

Chicago Conference May 1988: This time some 100 participants met for a well organized conference; three members of our Society presented papers. Elisabeth Clark is the new president; Chs. Kannengiesser the new vice-president. The next conference will convene in Loyola again on May 25-27, 1989.

Augustine Conference May 1987: The acts will be published; Joanne is the editor.

Our archives are ready to go to Ottawa.

Much praise was expressed for the quality of the Bulletin and for the good work done by Pierre Boglioni.

The 1988 Annual Conference of "THE AMERICAN INSTITUTE FOR PATRISTIC AND BYZANTINE STUDIES, INC." took place at the Greek island KOS July 10-13. Its theme was: "THE FATHERS AND EXPERIENCES OF ORTHODOXY".

Tsirpanlis, founder-president of the Institute, "The inner war in the ascetic experience of fourth century: St. Macarius the Great and Evagrius of Pontus". The Rev. Dr. John A. McGUCKIN (of Southampton, England), "The meaning of Orthodoxy in Patristic thought". Dr. Russel P. MOROZIUK (of Concordia Univ., Montreal), "Byzantine roots of Kievan Christianity as described in the Primary Chronicle, Povest Vremennyx Let". Dr. Despoina WHITE (of Georgia State College), "Church-State relations according to St. Photius of Constantinople". Vassilis CHATZIVASSILIOU, Esq., "Pages from the ecclesiastical history of KOS".

In addition to the two-days regular communications and the customary "Messages" & Addresses from Church leaders, local civil authorities & cultural societies, this year's program featured three general lectures presented by Prof. Angelo NEZERITIS (special VIDEO-Documentary on the Byzantine architecture of MYSTRAS, PATMOS, PAROS, KASTORIA, etc. and MT. ATHOS' S MONASTICISM), the Congressman of Dodecanissos Mr. Aristotle PAVLIDIS on "Greece as the meeting-point of West - East Cultural and Trade Re-unification", and Mr. Chrysis Michaelidis of the "RIZES" Society of Cyprus on "The meaning of the spiritual heritage and struggle in Cyprus".

Another notable feature of the 1988 program was the special presentation of Byzantine Hymns chanted by the only "Mixed" church Choir on the island of KOS headed & organized by the arch-cantor of "St. PARASKEVI" Cathedral, Mr. John VARKAS, on the occasion of the first day's "welcome - reception". After that beautiful musical "welcome", on the same evening, all the participants and guests together with the 16 Choir-members went to the KOS airport (on a special bus kindly offered by the mayor of KOS Mr. Kostas Kaiserlis), in order to greet & meet with the Patriarch of Alexandria PARTHENIOS. The participants were especially pleased to have the opportunity to visit and swim in the healthiest & most beautiful KEFALOS - Beach, more than one hour traveling by bus which was kindly offered by the V-TOURS AGENCY of Mr. Leonidas VOUKOUVALIDIS.

Finally, it should be noted that the two first issues (240 pages) of VOL. 7(1988) of THE PATRISTIC AND BYZANTINE REVIEW have been already published. They include scholarly studies on the seventh Ecumenical Synod, the theology of Icons, Egyptian & S. Italian Monasticism, Christology of Nestorius, the Bulgarian Christianity & Byzantium written by eminent scholars like J. IRMSCHER, J. McGUCKIN, K. STEINHOUSER, W. TREADGOLD C. N. TSIRPANLIS, CH. ASHANIN, METROPOLITAN EMIL. TIMIADIS, D. HESTER, et al.
